Topic: Hurricane Katrina Property and Business Interruption Claims – Complex Issues That Could Impact Companies Operating in California

This timely presentation will focus on business property and business interruption insurance with an emphasis on claims and will address such topics as: How can we anticipate the objections of insurers and see that our policies are written in ways that are more likely to cover loss? What is the best way to prepare and present a business interruption claim when the losses are caused by a combination of physical damage to the policyholder's property and damage to the wider geographic area?

Also to be discussed will be ingress/egress, civil authority and contingent business interruption coverage and claims, concurrent cause of loss, mold exclusions and other interesting claims and coverage issues.


